**Cllr A Chewings email to Cllr Athwal regarding HGV's in Sawley –**

Everyone agrees that there is a risk to pedestrians due to these high sided vehicles turning around and mounting the pavements to do so. Cllr K Athwal has had all the warning signs checked by DCC officers to ensure that they are compliant with UK law, along with having foliage cut back which was blocking some of the signs in question and also agreed to having two of the trees cut down that were blocking the illuminated warning sign on Tamworth Road near to Draycott Rd / Lock Lane a few years back.

Senior management at the Aldi distribution centre based on the B6540 have been approached to highlight the issues of HGV drivers ignoring the warning signs and Aldi agreed to install a warning sign on their premises to inform HGV drivers to turn left to access the A50 / M1 and not to turn right onto the B6540 as they leave the distribution centre DCC officers have also corresponded with providers of Satnav's for HGV's to reroute these vehicles away from low height bridge areas but there would probably need to be a change in law for this to take place. However there are legitimate businesses on Tamworth Rd that require deliveries of goods, along with local residents who have oversized goods delivered to their homes, so a weight limit restriction would be difficult to implement on Tamworth Road.
